Homework rules

Homework set 1	Create a leaflet that compares one country in the Middle East with one country in Africa. What is similar and different? Challenge: Explain why they are different.	Find 5 amazing buildings in the Middle East. Create a poster on them. Make sure you include a map showing their location.
	Create a fashion show appropriate for the Middle East.	Create a set of top trump cards on the Middle Eastern countries. You can make them yourself or find a template online.
Homework set 2	Design a football kit for England ready for the Qatar 2022 world cup.	Why are there so many billionaires in the Middle East?
	Create a Middle Eastern flag quiz.	Why is the Dead sea is called the Dead sea?
Homework set 3	Find out about the world heritage site Petra.	Why does Turkey want to join the EU? Why are they currently not in the EU?
	Create a word search of place names in the Middle East. Challenge: Rather than list the places in your word search give clues to make it harder.	Create a mascot for the Qatar 2022 world cup.
Homework set 4	Find out about Mesopotamia how is it linked to the Middle East now?	Create a Cyprus theme menu. What would be on there and why?
	Create a holiday broacher page for one place in the Middle East.	Find out what the game Assassins creed has to do with the Middle East.
Homework set 5	Create a building (either 3D or a sketch) that is completely sustainable and adapted to life in the Middle East. Make sure you annotate how it is sustainable.	Where is Patara and what is special about it?
	Create a fact file about sea turtles in Turkey. What type of sea turtles can you find there? What do they do in Turkey?	The UAE is a youthful population. What does this mean and what could be the consequences of a youthful population. Challenge: Can you find a population pyramid for the UAE and annotate it?
